THE OPPORTUNITY

Reporting directly to the Chief Operating Officer, the Senior Director of Operations and Logistics will serve as a key member of the leadership team and will partner closely with other directors and department leads across the organization. They will direct the organization's overall supply chain operations, including purchasing, receiving and managing inventory, coordinating with vendors, suppliers and donation partners, and distributing finished goods. The Senior Director of Operations and Logistics will work closely with the Executive Team to develop strategic and operational plans to improve productivity, profitability and growth with an emphasis on quality, and efficiency of operations. Additionally, they will create functional strategies, departmental goals and objectives, and develop and implement budgets, policies and procedures to support those strategies. The Senior Director of Operations and Logistics will provide the overarching leadership, management, and supervision of all day-to-day activities at Operation Gratitude's facility in Chatsworth, CA.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Plan and execute labor and equipment strategies for all logistics operations and warehouse functions.
- Develop, implement and refine standard operating procedures for logistics operations and warehouse management systems by analyzing process workflows, and functional and resource requirements.

- Develop care package production and distribution goals in close coordination with the Development and Program leaders and in support of the organization's strategic plan.
- Develop and execute an operating budget for logistics and warehouse operations, production and distribution, facilities and equipment maintenance, and labor; report on the facility's financial objectives by forecasting requirements, analyzing results and initiating corrective actions as necessary.
- Develop, maintain and report on performance metrics through daily monitoring of labor and productivity.
- Maintain a safe and healthy work environment by establishing, following, and enforcing standards and procedures.
- Develop departmental and individual goals and performance metrics.
- Mentor, train, and develop a team of professionals through engaged leadership, career progression and specific skills training.
- Build and cultivate team member morale, motivation, and loyalty by encouraging participation in assembly days, direct deliveries and other volunteer and community engagement activities.
- Other duties assigned by management.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE

- Bachelor's degree in Logistics or Supply Chain Management, a university degree in business or related field with a focus on supply chain management, inventory control, manufacturing, or materials management.
- 10+ years experience in supply chain management, with a demonstrated understanding of integrated supply chains and logistics concepts and theories, and a direct working knowledge of operations, warehouse management, and transportation management. 3PL experience preferred.
- 5+ years of managerial / supervisory experience
- Strong project management skills, including demonstrated ability to think independently, to be flexible and to juggle multiple priorities, work with little supervision, and to be tolerant of ambiguity and change.
- Experience in operational planning and business continuity strategies, particularly as it relates to supply chain and logistics.
- Demonstrates good judgement, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent administrative, organizational and time management skills, ability to set team and individual priorities and meet deadlines
- Sincere commitment to work collaboratively with, and provide a high level of "customer service" to, all constituent groups, including staff, board members, volunteers, donors, program participants, and other supporters.
- Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills.
- The ability to work some nights and weekends, and/or to travel, as needed.
